The Quarterly Census of Employment and Wage (QCEW) program is responsible for the compilation and analysis of employment, wage and contribution data by industry and geography for all employers covered by the Employment Security Law of North Carolina. Data include quarterly and annual summaries by industry of the number of firms, average employment, monthly employment, total wages, average weekly wages, taxable wages, and employer contribution rates to unemployment insurance. The industry data, based on the North American Industry Classification System (NAICS), is provided from 1990 to the present for North Carolina, the 14 Metropolitan Statistical Areas (MSAs), seven Economic Development Regions (EDRs), 24 Workforce Development Boards (WDBs), 18 Planning Regions and all 100 counties.
